April 15, 2013: Ron Silikovitz, Ph.D., a West Orange Psychologist, was the recipient of the second annual Philip N. Sobel Award at the Annual Meeting of the New Jersey Chapter of The Association of Family and Conciliation Courts on April 3.

Dr. Silikovitz was the founder and first president of the Chapter. The Association of Family and Conciliation Courts (AFCC) is an international, interdisciplinary association of professionals dedicated to improving the lives of children and families through the resolution of family conflict.

Philip N. Sobel, Esq. was the second president of the Chapter. His dream was to help litigants collaborate and resolve conflict without even going to court. He died in February, 2012. His spirit continues to energize the Chapter in advancing the AFCC mission.

Dr. Silikovitz has offices in West Orange and Elizabeth. He has practiced psychology since 1980. His specialties include individual, couples, and family therapy, as well as expert witness testimony in a variety of forensic psychology areas. He is also a parenting coordinator. He has served as Secretary and Treasurer of the New Jersey Psychological Association, and President of the Society of Psychologists in Private Practice (now known as the Essex-Union Counties Association of Psychologists).
